No person shall have, possess, carry or transport liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot or any other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing except in sealed bottles or other sealed containers, and no person shall drink or otherwise consume liquor, wine, beer or other alcoholic beverages in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot or any other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing in the Village of Bridgewater.

2. No person shall place, deposit, leave, abandon, break, smash or destroy any bottle, drinking glass, goblet or other glass container or receptacle in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot, or other public place or property in the Village of Bridgewater.

3. No person shall use offensive, disorderly, threatening, abusive or insulting language or conduct or behave himself or herself in an offensive, disorderly, threatening or insulting manner in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot, or other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing in the Village of Bridgewater.

4. No person or persons shall act or conduct themselves in such a manner as to annoy, disturb, interfere with, obstruct or be offensive to others, in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot, or other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing in the Village of Bridgewater.

5. No person shall congregate in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot, or other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing in the Village of Bridgewater in such a manner as to annoy, disturb, interfere with, obstruct or be offensive to others.

6. No person or persons shall (a) loiter, remain or wander about, (b) obstruct or otherwise interfere with the lawful passage of vehicular or pedestrian traffic, (c) engage in fighting or in any violent tumultuous or threatening behavior, (d) make any unreasonable noise or noises, (e) use abusive or obscene language or make obscene gestures, (f) congregate with other persons and refuse the lawful order of the police to disperse, (g) create a hazardous or physically offensive condition by any action or actions which serve no legitimate purpose in or upon any public sidewalk, street, highway, parking lot or any other public place or property or within or upon any vehicle while driving or standing in the Village of Bridgewater.

7. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Local Law shall be guilty of the offense of disorderly conduct and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$250.00 for each offense or by a maximum of fifteen days imprisonment in the County Jail or by both such fine and imprisonment and upon failure to pay such fine, such person shall be imprisoned in the County Jail until such fine is paid, not to exceed one day for each dollar of fine imposed.

8. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this Local Law shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof so declared to be invalid.

9. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
